After an obligatory review by the Editorial Board, papers will be published by the time the Conference begins in the periodical of the research series "Cognitive Studies of Language", included in the list of publications recommended by the Higher Assessment Board (HEB) of the Russian Ministry of Education and Science.

Registration fee

Registration fee (preparation and publication of the Conference proceedings and the programme as well as other expenses related to the organization of the Conference) is 4700 RUB (4000 RUB for members of the Russian Cognitive Linguists Association) and is paid **after you receive a letter confirming approval by the Editorial Board, which will include payment details**. Mailing fees are paid in addition to the amount of the registration fee. **Conference participants are expected to make their own travel and accommodation arrangements.**

Appendix 2. Formatting requirements

Materials for publication

Your papers should **not exceed 4 pages** in length in Microsoft Word format, version 6.0 and higher, Times New Roman Cyr font, size 14pt, single spaced, aligned by width. The first line indent should be automatically set at 10 mm; all margins should be set at 20mm. Do not use line spacing between paragraphs or double spacing. The author's name and surname should be indicated **in bold** and *italics* in the right-hand corner; city and country are written in italics in brackets; the name of the paper should be written in **CAPITAL** letters, **in bold**, and centered. Footnotes and endnotes are not allowed. Place citations in square brackets [Kubryakova 2004: 15].
