<i>Intended:</i> He <u>meant to write</u> a book after his trip.	<i>Involved:</i> Going there <u>means walking</u> far from home.

<i>A responsibility or sth that you need to do:</i> <u>Remember to drink</u> even if you are not thirsty.	<i>A memory of the past:</i> He <u>remembers experiencing</u> a feeling of emptiness when he arrived.
regret	
<i>A formal apology:</i> I <u>regret to inform</u> you that it has already been sold.	<i>A feeling of sadness about sth in the past:</i> He didn't <u>regret going</u> there.
stop	
<i>Paused in order to do sth:</i> They <u>stopped to visit</u> a ghost town.	<i>Completely finished sth:</i> She <u>stopped looking</u> for the book once she realized it was lost.
try	
<i>An effort to do sth difficult:</i> The <u>tried to set up</u> a business in the sixties.	<i>An experiment to see what will happen:</i> He <u>tried drinking</u> more water in the desert.
go on	
<i>Do sth after finishing sth else:</i> They <u>went on to read</u> after the break.	<i>Continue an action:</i> They waved and <u>went on riding</u> .
